Invasive Plant Points**

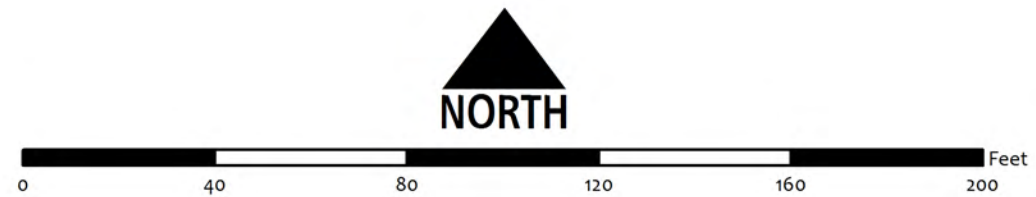
- japanese barberry (*Berberis thunbergii*)

- honeysuckle (*Lonicera morrowii*)
- multiflora rose (*Rosa multiflora*)
